This is to inform that the following subjects' syllabii and textbooks of II Languages of Intermediate first year have been revised w.e.f. the academic year 2018-19.

- a. Urdu - Part II
- b. Hindi - Part II
- c. Sanskrit - Part II
- d. Arabic - Part II

The new textbooks are prescribed and prepared by the Telangana State Board of Intermediate Education and published by Telugu Akademi, Hyderabad. The Principals, Lecturers and students are requested to follow the same. These books are available in the market.

It is also informed that the revised syllabii and model question papers of the above subjects are printed in the new textbooks, which will come into effect from the academic year 2018-19 and also available in the official website of TSBIE, i.e. www.bie.telangana.gov.in. However, the failed candidates are permitted to appear in these subjects with old syllabii textbooks in the ensuing Intermediate Public Examinations, March, 2019 and Advanced Supplementary Intermediate Public Examinations, May/June 2019 as a last chance.

All the Principals are requested to give wide publicity to the same among the students and Junior Lecturers and display a copy of this letter in the college notice board.
